Entrepreneurship also includes the ability to build an entrepreneurial or venture team to complement ones own skills and talents. It is the knock for sensing an opportunity where others see chaos, contradiction and confusion. It is possessing know-how to find, marshal and control resources (often owned by others).

Robert Hisrich viewed that entrepreneurship is the process of creating something different with value by devoting the necessary time and effort, assuming the accompanying financial, psychological and social risks and receiving the resulting rewards of monetary and personal satisfaction.

The Entrepreneur:

Entrepreneur is a Franch word and literally, translated means 'between taker' or 'go-between'

An Entrepreneur is a person who keeps his eyes and ears open to access the opportunities in environment, gather resources (men, material and many) to take advantages of the opportunity. He is a person who develops his enterprise He is a person of self confident problem solver, hard worker and

job-giver.

According to Joseph Schumpeter (1934) entrepreneur is an innovator and develops untried technology. In the words of karl Vesper (1980)

challange taker .He is a person of not job-seeker but

entrepreneur seen differently economist, psychologist, business person and politicians.

To an economist an entrepreneur is one who

brings resources, labour materials and other asserts into combinations that make their value greater than before and also one who introduce changes, innovations and a new order.

To a psychologist such a person is typically driven by certain forces-need to obtain or attain something to experiment, to accomplish, or perhaps to escape authority of others.

To one businessman, an entrepreneur appears as a threat, an aggressive competitor, whereas to another businessman the same entrepreneur may be

allay, a source of supply, a customer, or someone who creates wealth for others as well, who finds better ways to utilize, resources and reduce waste and who produces jobs for others.

The function of the entrepreneur is to reform

or revolutionsize the pattern of production by exploting an invention or, more generally, an untried technological possibility for producing a new commodity or producing an old one in a new way, opening a new source of supply of materials or new outlet for products, by reorganizing a new industry. In other words an entrepreneur must have certain values like independee, out standing performance, respect of work, positive attitude, ability and the competancy to receive and meet the challenges of an entreprenuerial society.
