এই বৃক্ষডালেই হৈছে বকো অঞ্চলৰ প্ৰথম উচ্চ শিক্ষানুষ্ঠান 'জৱাহৰলাল নেহৰু মহাবিদ্যালয়'। কেইজনমান অধ্যাপক আৰু ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীৰে আৰম্ভ হোৱা এই মহাবিদ্যালয়খনে অহা ২০১৪ চনৰ ২ আগষ্টত পঞ্চাশ বছৰ পূৰ্ণ কৰিব। কেবল মাত্ৰ কলা শাখাৰে আৰম্ভ হোৱা এই মহাবিদ্যালয়খনত যোৱা ১৯৮৬ চনত বিজ্ঞান শাখাৰ নতুনকৈ সংযোজন ঘটিল। তাৰ লগতে সংযোজন ঘটিল মণ্টেশ্বৰী শিক্ষকৰ প্ৰশিক্ষণ, কাঠফুলা খেতিৰ কৌশলৰ দৰে বৃত্তিমুখী শিক্ষাৰ। সেইদৰে মহাবিদ্যালয়খনত সংযোজন হ'ল কৃষকান্ত সন্দিকৈ ৰাজ্যিক মুক্ত বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ অধ্যয়ন কেন্দ্ৰ; যাৰ জৰিয়তে আধাতে শিক্ষাজীৱন সামৰা আৰু বিভিন্ন স্থানত কৰ্মৰত কৰ্মচাৰীসকলে স্নাতক আৰু স্নাতকোত্তৰ মহলাত অধ্যয়ন কৰিব পাৰে।

অন্য বহুজন ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীৰ দৰে আমিও এইখন মহাবিদ্যালয়তে অধ্যয়ন কৰি স্নাতক উপাধি লাভ কৰিছিলোঁ। পৰবৰ্তী কালত গুৱাহাটী বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ পৰা স্নাতকোত্তৰ পৰীক্ষাত উত্তীৰ্ণ হৈ এইখন মহাবিদ্যালয়তে শিক্ষক হিচাপে কাম কৰিবলৈ পাই আমি নিজকে ধন্য মানিছোঁ। আমাৰ দৰে বহুজন শিক্ষার্থীক জীৱনৰ পথ দেখুৱাই আগবাঢ়ি যাবলৈ সুবিধা কৰি দিছে এইখন মহাবিদ্যালয়ে। সেইকাৰণে এইখন মহাবিদ্যালয় শিক্ষা সমাপ্ত কৰা আৰু পঢ়ি থকা ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীসকলৰ লগতে অঞ্চলটোৰ ৰাইজৰ বাবে অতি আপোন।

পঞ্চাশ বছৰত ভৰি থোৱা বাবে যোৱা ২০১৩ চনৰ ৩ আগষ্ট তাৰিখৰ পৰা বছৰ জোৰা কাৰ্যসূচীৰে মহাবিদ্যালয়খনৰ সোণালী জয়ন্তী উৎসৱ পালন কৰিবলৈ ঠিক কৰি এখন উদ্যাপন সমিতি গঠন কৰা হৈছে। এই উদ্যাপন সমিতিৰ প্ৰচেষ্টাত ইতিমধ্যে যোৱা ২০১৩ চনৰ ৩ আগষ্টত জাকজমক কাৰ্যসূচীৰে ৰূপালী জয়ন্তী বৰ্ষৰ শুভাৰম্ভণি কৰা হৈছে। অহা ২০১৪ চনৰ আগষ্ট মাহৰ ৩, ৪ আৰু ৫ তাৰিখে এই সোণালী জয়ন্তী বৰ্ষৰ সামৰণি অনুষ্ঠান বিভিন্ন কাৰ্যসূচীৰে উদ্যাপন কৰা হ'ব। এই অনুষ্ঠানৰ লগত সংগতি ৰাখি প্ৰকাশ পাবলগীয়া স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখনৰ সম্পাদনাৰ দায়িত্ব আমাৰ হাততে ৰাইজে অৰ্পণ কৰে। আমি অন্য সদস্যসকলৰ লগত আলোচনা কৰি এখন পৰিকল্পনা যুগুত কৰি মহাবিদ্যালয়খনৰ বৰ্তমানৰ অধ্যক্ষ, অৱসৰপ্ৰাপ্ত অধ্যক্ষ, কৰ্মৰত আৰু অৱসৰপ্ৰাপ্ত অধ্যাপক-অধ্যাপিকা, প্ৰাক্তন আৰু অধ্যয়নৰত ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰী, অঞ্চলৰ বিজ্ঞান আৰু বিশিষ্ট লিখক-লেখিকাৰ ওচৰলৈ প্ৰবন্ধ-পাতি বিচাৰি চিঠি প্ৰেৰণ কৰিছিলোঁ। কিন্তু লিখকসকলৰ পৰা বহু পলমকৈ লিখনি অহা বাবে ছপাৰ কামো দেৱিকৈ আৰম্ভ কৰিব লগীয়া হয়। বহুতো লিখকে ২৫ জুলাইলৈকে লিখনি জমা দি থকাত সম্পাদনা সমিতিয়ে যথেষ্ট বিমোৰত পৰিব লগীয়া হয়। ফলত যথেষ্ট সাৱধানতা অৱলম্বন কৰা সত্ত্বেও কিছু ছপা ভুল থাকি গ'ল। তাৰবাবে লিখক আৰু পাঠকসকলৰ ওচৰত আমি ক্ষমা বিচাৰিছোঁ।

এই স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখন সম্পাদনা কৰোঁতে আমি কেইটামান বিশেষ কথাৰে লক্ষ্য কৰিছিলোঁ। স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখনৰ জৰিয়তে যাতে মহাবিদ্যালয়খনৰ সকলো দিশ প্ৰতিফলিত হয়, সেই কথাত বিশেষভাৱে গুৰুত্ব দিয়া হৈছিল। তাৰ লগতে বকো তথা দক্ষিণ কামৰূপ অঞ্চলৰ ঐতিহ্য, ভাষা-সাহিত্য-সংস্কৃতি আদি যাতে সঠিক দিশত প্ৰতিফলিত হয়, তাৰ প্ৰতিও লক্ষ্য ৰখা হৈছিল। সেইদৰে সাম্প্ৰতিক সময়ৰ ভাৰতৰ উচ্চ শিক্ষা, বৃহত্তৰ অসমৰ ভাষা-সাহিত্য-সংস্কৃতি বিষয়ক প্ৰবন্ধ-পাতি প্ৰকাশ কৰাতো আমি গুৰুত্ব দিছিলোঁ।

স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখনৰ বাবে প্ৰবন্ধ-পাতি বিচৰা, আৰ্হি কাকত চোৱা আদি কামত ৰাইজে ঠিক কৰি দিয়া সম্পাদনা সমিতিৰ সদস্যসকলৰ পৰা সহযোগিতা বিচাৰিছিলো যদিও কেইজনমান সদস্যৰ পৰা কোনো ধৰণৰ সহযোগেই নাপালোঁ। বৃহৎ কলেবৰৰ স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখনৰ সম্পাদনাৰ বিভিন্ন কামত, বিশেষকৈ আৰ্হি কাকত চোৱা কাৰ্যত সেয়েহে সম্পাদকে যথেষ্ট কষ্ট কৰিব লগীয়া হৈছিল। অৱশ্যে কেইজনমান সদস্যই সম্পাদকক বিশেষভাৱে সহায় কৰিছিল। সেইসকলৰ ভিতৰত শ্ৰীযুতা বিজয়া ডেকা, শ্ৰীযুতা ভৈৰৱী বড়ো, ড° দীপাঙ্কৰ শৰ্মা আৰু শ্ৰীযুতা ৰত্নমালা শৰ্মাৰ নাম ল'বই লাগিব। সম্পাদনা সমিতিৰ সদস্য নোহোৱা সত্ত্বেও কেইগৰাকীমান মহানুভৱ ব্যক্তিয়ে আৰ্হি কাকত চোৱা কামত আমাক বিশেষভাৱে সহায় কৰিছে। সেইসকলৰ ভিতৰত ড° গণেশ্বৰ চহৰীয়া, ড° কমলেশ্বৰ ঠাকুৰীয়া, ড° ক্ষীৰোদ কুমাৰ ঠাকুৰীয়া, শ্ৰীযুত লক্ষীকান্ত শৰ্মা চাৰ, শ্ৰীযুত মৃগেন শৰ্মা চাৰ, শ্ৰীযুত নীলমণি উপাধ্যায়, শ্ৰীপূৰ্ণ ৰাভা, শ্ৰীমতী সোমাইশ্ৰী খাখলাৰী, ছাত্ৰী কংকণা বড়ো, কবিতা বড়ো, আনন্ড বসুমতাৰী আৰু ৰিঞ্জুৰাণী বড়ো বিশেষভাৱে উল্লেখযোগ্য। বিজ্ঞাপন সংগ্ৰহত বিশেষভাৱে সহায় কৰিছে শ্ৰীযুত স্বাধীন বড়োই। সম্পাদনা সমিতিৰ সভাপতি শ্ৰীযুত বসন্ত কুমাৰ দত্ত চাৰ আৰু মহাবিদ্যালয়ৰ অধ্যক্ষ ড° নৃপেন গোস্বামী চাৰে আমাক বিভিন্ন দিহা-পৰামৰ্শৰে স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখনৰ সম্পাদনাৰ কামত আগবাঢ়ি যোৱাত সহায় কৰিছে। তদুপৰি মহাবিদ্যালয়খন স্থাপনৰ সময়ত যিসকল ব্যক্তি জৰিত আছিল, সেইসকল ব্যক্তিৰ নাম আৰু ফটো সংগ্ৰহ কৰিছে মহাবিদ্যালয়খনৰ কৰ্মচাৰী শ্ৰীযুত ভাৰত চৌধুৰীদেৱে। শেষ মুহূৰ্তত আমাৰ ছাত্ৰ শ্ৰীমানসপ্ৰতীম শৰ্মাই বিভিন্ন ঠাইলৈ গৈ কেইবাখনো ফটো সংগ্ৰহ কৰি দিছে। বকোৰ অভিভিয়া অফ্‌ছেটৰ স্বত্বাধিকাৰী শ্ৰীসুৰেশ কুমাৰ ৰাভা, ডি.টি.পি. অপাৰেটৰ শ্ৰীউৎপলা মজুদাৰৰ লগতে অন্য কৰ্মচাৰীসকলে অতি কম সময়ৰ ভিতৰতে অশেষ কষ্টকৰি স্মৃতিগ্ৰন্থখনি ছপাই উলিয়াইছে। এই সকলোৰে ওচৰত সম্পাদক বিশেষভাৱে ঋণী হৈ থাকিব।

50 YEARS OF JAWAHARLAL NEHRU COLLEGE, BOKO

THE BIRTH OF A GREAT INSTITUTION:

In the latter half of 1963, a public meeting was held in the premises of Boko high school with an agenda of establishing a college at Boko with a view to spread higher education in backward area like Boko. Accordingly after thread bare discussion the meeting resolved to establish a college at Boko from the next session. People from every nooks and corners of the area participated overwhelmingly in the meeting and constituted a preparatory committee with the then MLA of Boko LAC and Transport Minister of Assam as the President and late A.K. Adhikary, as secretary and late Janardan Sarma and Bibhas Bhadra as assistant secretaries was constituted.

Under the bold leadership of Late P.K.Choudhury, Late A.K. Adhikary, Late Janardan Sarma and Late Bibhas Bhadra and some other prominent persons of the locality. The movement for the Higher Education reached its culmination and people of the greater Boko area came out to fulfill their long standing desire to set up a college at Boko. The pioneers of the movement of the college at Boko, move at length and breadth of the area seeking public support in both cash and kinds and received enthusiastic response from every one in the area. Finally necessary correspondence was made with the University of Gauhati seeking permission to open the college. The liberal policy of the Gauhati University in granting permission and affiliation to open new institution in rural areas extended positive support for this institution to emerge at. With the untiring efforts

of a galaxy of enthusiastic people of the greater Boko area, the dreamed institution of higher education at Boko came in to its existence on the 3rd August of 1964. At the very beginning of the college, classes were held in the premises of Boko High School as an evening college. It will be the right time and right place on my part to express heartiest thanks to the then Managing Committee of Boko high school for according permission to hold classes in the premises of Boko high school. The managing committee was also pleased to allow honourable late Achyut Kanta Adhikary, the then headmaster of Boko High School and esteemed satradhikar of historic Chamaria Satra to act as part time incharge Principal and late Sarat Chandra Talukdar, and Mahendra Das, both are teachers of the school, as lecturers in Economics and History respectively. Sri B.K.Dutta was also appointed as lecturer in Assamese. With the part time in charge principal, three lecturers, one part time office assistant, two chawkidars and only sixty students on roll in the 1st year Pre-University class in the faculty of Arts was started initially. It was indeed, a great challenge for the sponsoring body at that time to run the college without having proper infrastructure. At this very moment of concluding ceremony of the Golden Jubilee, I as principal of the college express my profound gratitude to those people and the departed souls who took the pain of giving birth to such a great institute for enlightening the backward people of this locality with the waves of higher education.



As a result of endless efforts of the sponsoring committee of the college, particularly Late P.K.Choudhury, the pivotal point of the movement of the college, His Excellency the revered Governor of Assam was pleased to allot one hundred bighas (about 35 acres) of high land by dereserving the Jarapara village grazing reserved, just two kilometers west of Boko township on the National highway No-37. Late Deva Kanta Baruah, the then Education Minister of Assam, laid the foundation of the new building of the college at village Jarapara on an auspicious day of July 1964. Accordingly the new building of the college constructed at the new venue and classes were shifted from Boko High School to new college building. On this concluding ceremony of the Golden Jubilee of the college, I, on behalf of the college fraternity would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to those people whose goodwill in the form of donation and suggestion make the movement of the higher education at Boko a grand success.

THE VISION AND MISSION OF THE COLLEGE:

In real sense, higher education is meant to improve and develop the quality of human resource and human material. The basic objective of higher education is to create a good society, not only by developing an individual alone, but also by serving the social purpose which is very important for the well being of a nation. Over and above, all the needs, our education system should, not only be able to respond adequately to the 'demands' and 'challenges' of the society which are changing rapidly under the impact of new scientific and technological developments, but also become an effective instrument of much needed 'social change', which is capable of retaining our family and secular traditions even while accommodating new social and economic mobility.

The vision of the college is to set a hallmark in the field of education and to preserve, create, and disseminate knowledge through teaching, learning, innovation and experimentation to mould responsible individuals for leading a society with a hope for the

progress of the human race. The following missions aim at translating the visions of the college into action plans:

To create a healthy academic environment for promotion of quality education.

To develop a pool of highly educated individuals, who are not only competent in facing the present but also shaping the future.

To set an ideal standard for achieving excellence in the field of teaching and research.

To build a competitive infrastructure to attract students, teachers and researchers, seeking to translate dream in to reality.

To promote innovation in planning, teaching, and evaluation in achieving higher degree of perfection.

To document and preserve the rich ethnic, cultural and linguistic diversity of the region.

To make higher education a part of the social environment through community participation and thereby creating a social harmony.

THE UNIVERSITY AFFILIATION, RECOGNITION AND COURSES OF STUDY

Under the auspicious venture and untiring efforts of the sponsoring body, the University of Gauhati was pleased to accord first affiliation in 1964 up to the Pre-University class in Arts faculty. In the subsequent years, the college received permission to open 1st year B.A class in Arts. The college received degree affiliation in 1967 in the faculty of Arts. In due course of time in 1969 the college was brought under the deficit grant in aid scheme by the state government. It is a matter of great pleasure for all of us that in the same year the college was recognized by the UGC, the apex body of higher education in India, under section 2(f) and 12 (B). Finally the college obtained permanent affiliation from the Gauhati University from the session 1989-90. With the ever expanding horizon of the higher education in India, the demand for opening Science stream also gained momentum and accordingly to cater to the need of the enthusiastic students of the locality, the authority decided to start science education. Accordingly in the year 1986 the



science stream was added to the courses of study of the college. After obtaining necessary permission and Government concurrence, the government of Assam was pleased to bring the science stream of the college under deficit grant in aid scheme of the state Government in the year 1998. In this respect, I gratefully acknowledge the names of Sri Thanewar Boro and Sri Jyoti Prasad Das, the then Education Minister of Assam and MLA of Boko LAC respectively, who took keen interest in bringing the Science stream under the deficit grant in aid scheme.

At the beginning, the subjects introduced in the college in Pre-University and Degree were English, Assamese MIL, Alternative Assamese, and Assamese Second language, Economics, Political Science and History in arts stream. Later on, two more subjects Geography and Anthropology were introduced in the courses of study with necessary permission and affiliation from Gauhati University. In the faculty of science Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany and Zoology are being taught in both HS and under graduate level.

CONTACT CENTRE OF INSTITUTE OF DISTANCE AND OPEN LEARNING:

The college not only caring its regular students, but also paying heed to the non institutional private students also so that a balance in the standard of education can be maintained. With a broad view to facilitate those people, remaining outside the educational institution, for higher education the contact centre of Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL) in our college was established in the year 2003 under Gauhati University through which students may take admission in to the Institute for various courses.

ESTABLISHMENT OF STUDY CENTRE UNDER KKHSOU:

The academic achievement of the students of this locality is not up to the mark and a good number of students fail in their examinations apart from a large number of dropouts. To facilitate such students in

acquiring higher education the college has established a study centre under the Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University (KKHSOU) in the year 2008. In real sense the centre is a boon for the dropout student of the locality as because they can carry out their education in the study centre of the University. At present this center has been rendering a commendable role in the arena of higher education at Boko where students may pursue their studies up to PG level.

STATUTORY AND NON STATUTORY BODIES THAT GUIDE US:

After bringing the college under Deficit Grant in Aid Scheme of the State government in 1969, the college was governed under the Assam Aided College Management Rule. Later on, in 2005, the State government was pleased to bring the college under the Assam Provincialised College Management Act, 2005. For the smooth management of the college and as per provision of the rules, there is a Governing Body which is responsible to mould the framework of its journey to ahead. With the advice of National Assessment and Accreditation council another limb in the name of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was added to the management system of the college. This IQAC can be said to be the think tank of the college in chalking out and monitoring of the action plans for future development of the college.

THE CAMPUS:

In the midst of a lush green vegetative cover the college took its possession in the Jarapara VGR that was allotted to the college by the government of Assam. The first Assam type building measuring 140 feet by 27 feet including a Verandah was completed approximately at a cost of rupees 55000.00. At the completion of the building the classes were shifted from Boko high School to this newly constructed building at permanent site on 13th Aug 1967. The construction of this permanent building on the own land of the college is definitely a land mark in the



history of J. N. College. Later on in due course of time and with the demand of time, more buildings were constructed which make the college a full-fledged one of its kind.

THE CLASS ROOM:

To meet the growing demand of class room, the college authority had started construction of several class rooms at different points of time. Accordingly construction of an Assam type RCC building was under taken by the then Governing Body with a floor area of 4788 sq feet which was inaugurated by late P.K Choudhury in a ceremonial function on 4-8-1971. Subsequently more class rooms were constructed to meet the growing demand with different grants and aids from Government of Assam and UGC.

CONSTRUCTION OF NEW ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING:

Lack of proper accommodation for the administrative works of the college was always felt but due to lack of fund it was not possible to construct the same. To meet the challenge of construction of the Administrative building, the Governing Body of the College undertook a comprehensive plan for construction of a RCC building. Accordingly in 2009 the present principal of the college laid the foundation of the Administrative building with a provision of extension of two more floors. The building was completed in 2011 and the office was shifted to the same in the same year.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY:

A library is the soul for an educational institution. Unfortunately the college did not have a permanent building to harbour its library. In the recent past the college authority was in puzzle in accommodating the library and therefore library had to be shifted from one place to another more frequently. Apprehending the inconvenience, the authority initiated to construct a new library building and accordingly the 1st floor of

the Administrative building was constructed as the new library. The construction of the same was completed in the latter half of 2012 and the library has been shifted to the new building in the same year in a ceremonial atmosphere. During the last few years, utmost efforts have been taken to develop the college library not only from its stock in books, references, reprography, journals etc but also from its infrastructure. Apart from its traditional status, at present the library of the college is a purely computerized one and equipped with internet and documentation facilities. Students are allowed to access the library freely so that they can choose books from the stock. Several internet links have also been set-up with different world class libraries all over the globe with a view to give an exposure of the changing faces of the system to our students and teachers. Now it is possible for the readers, our students and faculty to have a direct access to all these world class libraries of the globe through internet. The reading room of the library can accommodate more than 50 students and 15 teachers at a time.

So far the college library is equipped with 21284 numbers of books, 20 Magazines, 25 current national and international journals and 7 number of news paper of national and international standard. Further, all the departments of the college have a departmental library with good number of books in stock. Faculty members and Major students can take the advantage of the departmental library in pursuing education.

THE CONFERENCE HALL:

For holding seminar, workshop, symposia, and other relevant function, a state of the art conference hall is of utmost necessity for an institution of higher education like this college. Previously the college auditorium was used for the purpose. But the same is quite incompetent to hold such functions which pave the way to go for a new state of the art conference hall. Accordingly with the financial aid from KKHSOU a sophisticated IT equipped conference



hall was constructed which was opened for service to the people of Boko on 5th Nov 2014.

WOMENS' HOSTEL:

It is known to all of us that we are having students from remote places like Assam Meghalaya interstate boundary area where transport and communication facility is not sound enough. Further the incumbents are also not sound enough economically that they can afford to stay at rented house at Boko. To facilitate such students for pursuing higher education the college authority and IQAC of the college had under taken an integrated action plan to construct a women's' hostel in the college campus. Accordingly a comprehensive plan was prepared and submitted to the UGC requesting necessary fund. Fortunately the UGC was pleased to approve the proposal and accorded a grant of Rs 57 lakh. With the grant received from the apex body of higher education, the authority of the college constructed a two storied women's' hostel in the college campus. The hostel building is by now ready to accommodate 70 Girl students. It is a matter of great pleasure for us that the UGC has pleased to sanction another grant of 43 lakh on the request of the college authority for extension of the women hostel.

THE SPORTING COMPLEX :

Games and Sports is a part and parcel of an academic environment. To build the sporting attitude in the minds of our students a sound infrastructure is of utmost necessity. Under the influence to create a proper sporting environment the college authority felt the necessity of an outdoor stadium, a Swimming pool and an intrigrated Sports Training Complex. To materialize the dream of a sound sporting environment, the authority approached the Rabha Hassong Autonomous council for a mini stadium and paying heed to our request the CEM of Rabha Hassong Council Dr..Sarat Rabha accorded a grant of Rs 50,00000/- for the construction of a mini-stadium of which foundation stone was laid by Dr.Haren Das

on behalf of Bhubaneswar Kalita, the then MP of Rajya Sabha o 4th July 2008 and finally the stadium was inaugurated by Dr. Sarat Rabha on 3rd Aug,2009.

It is a matter of great pleasure to inform that under the scheme of UGC and at the untiring efforts of the college authority, the college has managed to obtain a financial grant of Rupees one crore for the construction of a Swimming pool in the College. The construction of the same is on the verge of its completion and hope the students of the college will be able to enjoy the benefit of it.

To extract the sporting potentialities of our students, the college authority also approached the UGC seeking financial grant for a Sports Complex in the College campus. Accordingly an estimate of Rs 70, 00000 was placed before the UGC. Fortunately the statutory body of higher education was pleased to approve the project of which the construction process is in progress and hope the student will be able to enjoy the benefit of it soon.

THE GUEST HOUSE:

Boko is rural area where there is no good provision of accommodating guests. Therefore the guests invited to college as resource persons for different seminars, workshops etc was a great problem to the authority. Keeping the inconvenience in consideration we have approached Sri Bhubaneswar Kalita, the honourable member of Rajya Sabha. We must offer our gratitude to Sri Bhubaneswar Kalita according a grant amounting to Rs 21.50 lakhs of which the foundation stone was laid by honourable DC of Kamrup Dr. J. Balaji on 30th June 2014. It is expected that the construction committee will be able to complete the work within stipulated time period.

COLLEGE GARDEN:

The college was set up by our predecessors in the midst of a lush green vegetative cover of former Jarapara VGR. The greenness of the campus and its surrounding itself is a added beauty to the college. Yet then a collection of floristic varieties in the campus



will add more beauty to the college and for this purpose the college authority approached the BDO, of Boko Sri Pankaj Chakrabarty and requested a grant for the construction of a Garden in the College Campus. It is a matter of great pleasure for all of us that the BDO of Boko with the District administration sanctioned us with a grant of Rs 5 lakhs for construction of the Garden under MGNREGA scheme. The work of the garden is on progress.

IQAC:

With the new trend of globalization in all walks of life, the education system is also not untouched by the trend. The age old and traditional methods of life styles now becoming obsolete and a wave of new standard of living with the state of the art technology have been coming up. Keeping pace with the new trend of development the J.N. College, Boko also marching ahead to provide better academic environment for its students. To ensure a world class quality in our service, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell was constituted in the year 2005. This statutory body of the college has been actively working to ensure quality in all atmosphere of the college. In order to revamp the IQAC and to add more functionality in its progress the UGC has accorded a grant amounting to Rs. 3 Lakhs in the 12th plan. With a view to bring the college to the national standard, the IQAC has accredited the college for two times on 15th and 16th December 2004 and 5th, 6th and 7th May 2014 by NAAC. In the 1st cycle of accreditation the college could have obtained C⁺⁺ Grade. But after the continuous and untiring efforts of the IQAC and other stakeholder of the college, in the 2nd cycle of accreditation we could have bagged 'B' grade of 4 point grading system. At this special moment it is obviously a matter of great pleasure for all of us. Target has been set to obtain the top grade 'A' in the next cycle of accreditation.

NETWORK RESOURCE CENTRE:

Keeping broad view of introducing our students and faculties with different resource centres of

academic pursuits, the college had ventured to establish a network resource centre in the college. Wireless connections are available in the Network Resource Centre so that students can browse internet free of cost uninterruptedly for academic purpose.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMME:

The college has been continuously running both Under Graduate and H.S courses in Arts and Science of Gauhati University and Assam Higher Secondary Council. Apart from these courses, the college had applied the Gauhati University seeking permission for starting PGDCA as a curriculum in the college. Fortunately the affiliating university has accorded necessary permission to open the same from the current session and hope the students will come forward to avail the benefit of the course.

CARRIER ORIENTED PROGRAMME:

This age of lack of Employment Avenue all over the country and more particularly in places like Boko, the scope of Carrier Oriented Programme is of utmost necessity. Under the Carrier Oriented Programme of UGC, the college had applied for opening such course in the college. We must offer our heartiest thanks to the UGC for granting permission to open two Carrier oriented Programmes- Mushroom Cultivation and Montessori Training and accorded a grant amounting Rs 10, 00000 and 700000 respectively. At present both the courses are running pleasantly.

RESEARCH:

Apart from normal class room activities, the teachers are engaged in both major and minor research works within the college campus. It is a matter of great pleasure for all of us that within a period of 9 years the teaching faculties of the college have completed 23 research projects funded by different research agencies. Out of the total 23 projects, 9 major research projects and 18 minor research projects. Still 3 major projects and four minor projects are ongoing and expected to be completed soon.



Several research papers have so far been published in journals of both National and International reputation with appreciable impact factor. Teachers of the college are always been encouraged by the authority to involve themselves in research and to disseminate their findings so that we can contribute to the social development process.

NATIONAL SEMINAR:

To create awareness towards the vital issues of the locality the college has organized several National level seminars at different time. On 24th and 25th of October 2008, the college had organized a National Level Seminar on the topic Wetland and Livelihood. Subsequently on 30th November 2012, the Assamese department had organized another National level seminar on the topic Literature, Culture, and Philosophy of Sankardeva. Recently, keeping pace with the Golden jubilee celebration of the College, the Geography department organized a National Level Seminar on 6th and 7th November 2013 on a relevant topic, Forest Resources of Assam, Depletion, Regeneration and Challenges of Conservation. Dignitaries, researchers, and participants from different parts of the country presented research papers which added more to the meaning of these seminars.

UGC AND THE COLLEGE :

It has been mentioned earlier that the college was recognized by UGC under 2(f) and 12 (B) on 26 September 1969. As such, the college is entitled to receive grants from the UGC. For the all round development of the college, the college authority placed several schemes in the 11th and 12th plan before the apex body of higher education and accordingly to our expectation we have received 80.85 lakh and 48.01 lakh during the 11th and 12th plan respectively. The aforesaid grants for the 11th plan have been spent on respective schemes within stipulated time period and 12th plan grant yet to be released by the UGC.

STAR COLLEGE:

It is a matter of great pleasure for all of us that the Department of Biotechnology under the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India has recognized our college as a star college. This will add extra weightage to the college and financial help from the DBT will make the college a centre of excellence.

LABORATORY AUGMENTATION:

It was the demand of time and also of the utmost necessity to development and augments our laboratories so that our student can perform their academic practical works in a congenial and convenient laboratory. With the grants received from UGC all most all the departmental laboratories of the college have been augmented with sophisticated instruments and basic infrastructure.

ESTABLISHMENT OF BIOTECH HUB :

Another important addition to the infrastructure of J. N. College, Boko is the establishment of a Bio-Tech Hub in the year 2010 with the financial assistance of Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India. This sophisticated laboratory of Biological Science is not only an asset of the college but will served the enthusiastic people of the locality. So far this laboratory has conducted several academic programmes particularly for the benefit of the school teachers of the feeding schools of the College. The basic objective of this laboratory is to develop a scientific temperament among the student of the locality.

ESTABLISHMENT OF GIS LAB AND WEATHER STATION:

Alike biological science, for the benefit of the students of the earth sciences and spatial sciences a sophisticated GIS laboratory was also setup in the year 2012 with the financial aid from UGC. Along with the GIS laboratory an automatic weather station was also setup in the college to get weather related informations of the greater Boko area. It will be a great help for students, teachers and interested persons



of the locality to have firsthand information of the weather of Boko area.

LANGUAGE LAB:

From the experience of association with this college it is clear for us that our students cannot do well in English. Majority of our student become unsuccessful in English every year which dismayed all of us. Apprehending the issue in view and with the recommendation of the NAAC in its 1st cycle of accreditation, a language laboratory was setup under the department of English. The basic idea of the language lab is to impart training on functional English to our students. So far the laboratory has been imparting education on spoken English and soft skill development course to our students. It is hoped that the laboratory will be able to solve the issue that persist in our academic environment of the college.

COLLEGE TOWARDS GREEN ENVIRONMENT:

The college authority is always interested to maintain a peaceful and green environment in each campus. In order to maintain the greenness in the campus different wings of the college involve in new plantation. To check the biodiversity loss several workshop awareness campaign etc. are organized by NSS, Rover & Ranger, Science Forum and other

organization of the college. Students are always advice to use bicycles other than motor bike and teachers are insisted to use common vehicles instead of individual one so that pollution of the atmosphere can be reduced.

INITIATIVE TOWARDS SELF SUSTAINABLE ECONOMY:

The college authorities always paying heed to rational use of resources and believe on a self sustainable economy. With a view to develop self sustenance in each economy rubber cultivation had been started in collaboration with Central Rubber Board in an area covering almost 13 acres of land in each campus. It is expected that this project will turn over not less than 10 Lacs per annum after next 5 to 7 years.

We solicit every new idea and innovation for the betterment of the college as well as the people of the locality. We appeal the well wishers, students, ex-students, teachers and the public to extend their help and cooperation to make the institute a centre of excellence so that we can fulfill the aspirations of the students and people of the area and make a mark in the field of higher education.

FIFTY GLORIOUS YEARS OF JAWAHARLAL NEHRU COLLEGE AT BOKO

In the article "Twenty five years of Jawaharlal Nehru College at Boko" published in the silver Jubilee and Nehru Centenary commemoration Volume 1964 – 1989 this writer made an attempt to trace the history of the college since its inception to November 1989 pointing out the stress and strains through which it had passed and also its achievements and failures during the first 25 Years of its existence. Now the College is at the threshold of celebrating its final phase of yearlong celebration Golden Jubilee when it completes 50 glorious years on August 2, 2014.

This humble self joined the College as its fulltime permanent Principal on September 1, 1965 and retired from the post on superannuation on May, 31, 1995 after serving the institution for long 30 years. During the tenure of office as Principal of the College, this writer had the good fortune to be closely associated with Gauhati University as member of the court for 28 years (1967 to 1995), member of the Executive Council for 6 years (1987-1994), member of the Academic Council (1994 – till retirement) and Associate Inspector of Colleges under the university from 1987 to 1995.

When the present writer arrived on the scene and joined as the Head of the Institution, it was purely at the venture stage, receiving no Govt. grants in aid, having no buildings of its own, but functioning in the premises of the local Boko High School in the evening shift with Sri A.K. Adhikary, B.A., Headmaster of the School working as part-time honorary Principal in-charge, three full-time teachers, Sri Basanta Kr. Dutta, Sri Madan Choudhury, Sri Priyada Ranjan

Das, two part-time teachers, Sri Sarat Chandra Talukdar and Sri Mahendranath Das; one part time office Assistant Sri Pranab Das and two 4th grade employees Sri Jadab Kalita and Dilip Das Gupta.

The new Principal had to begin from scratch. Under his stewardship, with the active help and support of the sponsoring Body in the initial stage and hold of the Governing Body led by Sri P.K. Choudhury, Sri A.K. Adhikary and Sri Janardan Sarma, the college grew from strength to strength. It must be acknowledged that due to untiring efforts of Sri P.K. Choudhury the college received a recurring Govt. grant of Rs. 1000/- per month from July/1966 and His Excellency the Governor of Assam allotted a plot of 100 bighas (33 acres approximately) of land by deserving a part of Jarapara V.G.R. by the northern side of N.H.37, 2 KM West of Boko P.S. and the College was brought under Deficit grant in-aid with 72 students on roll from September 1, 1969. The College received first Degree affiliation under GU in 1967.

Sri P.K. Choudhury was also instrumental in getting non-recurring building grants sanctioned to the college from time to time. The first Assam type College Building measuring 140' x 20' with a verandah of 14' x 7' and porch 20' x 20' was constructed at a cost of Rs. 55,000/- (Rupees fifty-five thousand) and the day classes were shifted to it from Boko High School on August 13, 1967. Another modern RCC building with University specifications and floor area of 4788 sft. constructed at a cost of Rs. 81,000/- was ceremonially opened on 4.8.71 by Sri P.K.



Chaudhury and classes were shifted to it from that date and the first building was converted into a Boys' Hostel. In 1972 an Assam type Administrative Building with floor area of 1200 sft. was constructed to accommodate the Principal's Office, Teachers Common Room, College Office and College Library.

But most unfortunately Sri Probin Kumar Chaudhury died suddenly on 16th November, 1975. His untimely passing away left an aching void in the growth and development of the institution. The Principal single handedly had to bear the brunt of academic expansion and infrastructure development of the college. The twin hurdles since its inception were paucity of funds and low enrolment. The enthusiasm of the people who started the college died down soon and a collection drive was launched on February, 1966. During the Pre-deficit period Mobile Theatre parties were invited to stage shows in aid of the college. The problem of low enrolment of the College was aggravated in 1972 with the introduction of Assamese as medium of instruction in colleges under Gauhati University as the local Garo students migrated to Barapani, Tura and other colleges in Meghalaya and also for establishment of two more colleges at Nagarbera and Dudhnoi.

Impact of Political events on the College:

Despite nationwide opposition, Mrs. Indira Gandhi Govt. declared National Emergency on June 26, 1975 which gave the govt. to curb growing indiscipline and rowdiness in educational institutions, leading sometimes to closure of universities, colleges and other educational institutions temporarily, to tone up the administration by vigorously enforcing rules of discipline, good behavior and order. Leaving aside the political aspect of the Emergency, it made salutary impact on educational institutions. A new sense of dedication and discipline grew among the staff and students.

In our college several welfare measures, including introduction of Uniforms and badges for all students, opening of Book-Bank for poor and needy students, forming of a co-operative society for staff,

students and other employees for supplying essential commodities at controlled prices and text-books to students at concessional rates, construction of a cycle shade, appointment of a librarian etc. were initiated.

As a result of these welfare measures complete peace and tranquillity prevailed on the campus and a new sense of patriotism was generated among the students.

Expansion of Academic facilities:

After the lifting of the Emergency and holding the General election, the Janata Party formed the Govt. led by Sri Morarji Desai at the Centre and in Assam Golap Barboria formed the Janata Party Govt. in 1977. Under the Janata Party Govt., Gauhati University granted permission to the college to open Honours in Economics and Assamese in TDC from the session 1977-78 and to introduce Anthropology, Education and Geography in Pre University course from the session 1979-80.

Meanwhile, the Assam Movement, spearheaded by All Assam Students' Union and All Assam Gana Sangram Parishad, against illegal infiltration of foreign nationals into the state started in June 1979, had a deep impact on the student community and educational institutions throughout the state. Students boycotted their classes, the two Universities and the Secondary Education Board could not hold their examinations in 1980. The students and teachers of this College also plunged headlong in the movement as a result of which there was no new admission in 1980. The six year long movement culminated in signing the M.O.U. between the Movement leaders and the Govt. of India in the early hours of August 15, 1985. It is worth recalling that our College accorded a hero's welcome and grand reception to the leaders of the movement headed by Sri Prafulla Kr. Mahanta on 13th September, 1985 when they returned from New Delhi after signing the M.O.U.

Introduction of Science Stream :

After signing of the M.O.U., the Assam Movement leaders formed the Asom Gana Parishad
